Market Steer Exhibitor Rules Acknowledgement and Homegrown Verification

Market Steer Exhibitors/Parents please be advised of the following rules when it comes to your 2023 Pensacola Interstate Fair Market Steer Project, This rules acknowledgement must be signed and turned back in BEFORE you can weigh your steer in for initial weigh-in.

- Please feed your steer not to just win but for a tasty product for buyers to eat. This is a terminal project with a good quality project as the end goal.
- Cheaper and or less feed isn't the best alternative to a successful project. Quality is important!
- Every exhibitor is responsible for securing a processor appointment date. It should be communicated with and understood by your buyer which processor and the date that their steer will be processed. You need to let Andy know which processor you are using and what your appointment date and time will be <u>TODAY!</u>
- It's your responsibility to provide feed, feed pan, water bucket/pan, and to feed your own steer or arrange for someone to feed your steer until it goes to the processor at the conclusion of the show. If the fair has to provide feed and take care of your steer the cost of that care will be deducted from the final auction check. If you have any questions concerning the care of your steer, please don't hesitate to ask.
- Everyone will declare either FFA or 4-H as of this date (06/03/2023). No exceptions.
- All home grown steers must be declared today ONLY. Escambia County, FL, Santa Rosa County, FL, Escambia County, AL, Baldwin County, AL, or Monroeville, AL are the only counties of purchase that are eligible for homegrown.
