Art Guidelines:

- Your art should be mounted/matted or on pedestals/tables that you supply.
- Please use the Official Fair Tag and attach securely to each art piece there should be NO HANDWRITTEN tags.
- Please be careful which glue is used to mount work because it doesn't always hold for the complete length of the fair. Heavier pieces will need more support. No glue sticks or clear tape. The building has a lot of humidity.

Please hang art in building number (2) two at the fairgrounds on Hang Dates listed above

Use the Godwin Lane entrance to hang artwork.
